SUBJECT: Rescinding of USFK-wide Curfew Policy

1. References:

a. General Order Regarding Off-Installation Curfew (19 December 2014).

b. USFK Regulation 27-5, Individual Conduct and Appearance, Paragraph 5-2, Curfew, 9 July 2015.

2. After careful consideration, the USFK-wide curfew is rescinded effective immediately. Eliminating the curfew will promote even stronger relationships between U.S. service members, their families, and our Korean neighbors and help solidify Korea as the Assignment of Choice.

3. Every service member, civilian employee, and family member is an ambassador in Korea and each is responsible for demonstrating positive behavior to exhibit the high-level of respect we have for our host nation and its citizens. Commanders and leaders at all levels are responsible for maintaining good order and discipline and all of us are responsible for maintaining the readiness which makes our fighting force lethal. We must all be good teammates to ensure we collectively adhere to our high standards.
