SUBJECT: Elimination of 7 AF (AFKOR) General Order Regarding Off-Installation Curfew

1. It is with great pleasure that I inform you that the Commander, United States Forces Korea, in concert with his component commanders, has determined to rescind the current command-wide curfew policy effective Tuesday, 17 December 2019.
2. The Republic of Korea and U.S. Airpower Team has never been stronger and is key to the security of Northeast Asia now and will continue to be for the foreseeable future. As 2019 comes to a close and 2020 begins, it is imperative that each of you continue to practice individual discipline, maintain professional standards, and make positive choices as ambassador Airmen who are respectful of our Korean hosts.

The responsibility for maintaining good order and discipline falls to commanders and senior enlisted leaders at every level, but being great Airmen, applying our core values both on and off-duty, and taking care of our Wingmen are the obligations of every one of us. I charge each of you with maintaining standards in line with our core values and taking note that the actions of a few can lead to unintended consequences for many.
4. Every Airman serving throughout Seventh Air Force plays a critical part in promoting peace and stability throughout the Korean peninsula. Our Airpower team must continue to maintain a high state of military readiness and always be ready and able to "Fight Tonight."
